




# **Current Water Supply Levels**



# Percent of Target Water Supply Curve November 18: 36.6% Target Water Supply Curve: 55,154 acre-feet Current Storage: 20,206 acre-feet



Click here to check out current water supply levels for Lake Sonoma and Lake Mendocino With the lack of sustained, productive rainfall so far this season and the lingering drought from the past season, Lake Sonoma and Lake Mendocino are both below average. The past 4 years have been record dry years and so far this season we are pushed even further below the curve. As of November 29, 2021, Lake Sonoma is at 49.9% of capacity which is nearly 90,000 acre feet below average for this time of year. Lake Mendocino is at 37%, which is nearly 37,000 acre feet below the Target Water Supply Curve.



### Winter Water Use Impacts Sewer Rate Calculations

Sewer service <u>providers</u> with volumetric based rates calculate the volumetric portion of the sewer charges based on your winter water usage. *High winter water use will result in higher volumetric based sewer charges for the entire year.* 



Using less water during the winter months can keep the volumetric portion of your sewer

charges lower. Be sure to turn off your outdoor irrigation, fix leaks and resist the urge to take those long, hot showers on those cold winter mornings.

Water conservation is not seasonal, conservation is a way of life!
